

Sayings of Hazrat Ali (AS):

Knowledge is better than Wealth because of seven reasons:

- 3. Wealth requires to be protected, while knowledge protects its owner.
- 4. Knowledge will enter the Kafan (Shroud) while wealth will be prevented from doing so.
- 5. Wealth reaches both believers and unbelievers (Kafir), while knowledge is reserved only for those who are worthy of it.
- 6. Knowledge will facilitate passing over the Seraat (Bridge over Hell) while wealth will pore hurdles.
- 7. People are always in need of scholars while they might not be in need of those possessing wealth.

Introduction

In a rapidly changing world, where it is virtually impossible to predict what abilities and skills will be required for the next generation, the establishment of University Cambridge School in University Town by Madina Foundation, a philanthropic organization, is a vital step towards promoting quality education. Our aim is to ensure that our students are confident and capable learners, with a strong sense of self worth who will be able to adjust and meet whatever demands are placed upon them.

It is one of our firmly-held beliefs that education is a wide-ranging process, not confined to academic goals and that above all it should be an enjoyable experience for the students.

Children are continually challenged to attain higher standards, so it is important that expectations are high, both academically and personally. Through a range of teaching styles, the staff fosters a positive atmosphere of mutual respect and trust to create an environment where pupils feel safe, unthreatened and valued. In this way we hope that they will develop self-motivation and a sense of personal worth.

Salient Academic Features

The School

- ☼ Has a dynamic atmosphere that promotes the development of critical and disciplined thinkers who are inspired by the joy of learning.
- Believes that teachers are highly trained professionals who are in a position of trust and who are bound by moral and ethical obligations.
- Believes that parents are the first teachers of the child and that mother and father must play an integral role within the school.
- Promotes ethical and compassionate behavior in all as we share knowledge and begin to acquire wisdom in a climate of trust and hope.
- Seeks to develop the potential of the human mind by attending to the physical, intellectual, social and emotional development of students.
- Believes that the strength of character necessary for co-operation and collaboration comes from self-confidence and high self-esteem.

Admission and Registration

The admission procedure begins with Registration, A registration fee is charged to cover the clerical and administrative cost.

Admission Requirements

There are no academic requirements for acceptance into Pre-Nursery, Children at this level are interviewed only. They must be able to speak and follow simple instructions. Tests for all classes are conducted in English, Urdu and Mathematics to determine student's placement.

Following documents are to be submitted at the time of registration.

- Complete Application Form
- Complete Health Form
- Five Photographs (4cmx 6cm)
- Copy of Student's Original Birth Certificate or B-Form
- Copy of Parent's (both) ID Cards
- Original Report Card for the last one year

Fee

School fee and other charges shall be paid for every two months in advance and is payable for all twelve calendar months. Payment of all fees and other charges should be made through the specified banks.

The school has the discretion to review and increase the school fees and all other charges without prior written notice.

Withdrawal

If parents wish to withdraw their child from the school, one month's notice in writing must be given to the school. One month's fees must be paid to the school in lieu of such notice. No notice is required, however, if a student is withdrawn one month after the final examination.

Not withstanding the above, a student shall be considered to be withdrawn from the school if:

- a. S/he has not attended the school for a period of one month, unless arrangements for such absence have been agreed to by the Principal.
- b. His/her fees have remained unpaid for two consecutive months.

- c. S/he has been asked to withdraw from the school due to disciplinary reasons. In case of such withdrawal the school shall not be required to give any notice before enforcing its decision, which shall be within the absolute and sole discretion of the school.
- d. S/he has failed in the same class for two consecutive years or has failed to qualify for promotion on two different occasions in his/her school career.
- e. In case of (a), (b), (c) and (d) above, outstanding fees shall be adjusted against the security deposit paid to the school.

School Curriculum

The curriculum of the school refers to the many activities designed to promote the intellectual, social, physical and personal development of its pupils. In addition to the formal teaching sessions in a day, it includes the 'hidden' curriculum, the relationships and values evident at school.

A Quality Education

UCS believes in bringing cost effective quality education which is achieved by:

- Planning
- Teaching
- Testing and Feedback

Planning

Weekly detailed plans for each subject are prepared; including all the topics to be taught and all the points to be explained. Each plan represents complete aims and objectives of the topic and is designed to complete in a specific time. It is followed by activities and is merged into following themes.

Teaching Methods

Flexible and accommodating teaching strategies are used that cater for different ability levels. Students centered learning is encouraged. At the same time they are encouraged in creativity, foster collaboration and peer learning. Teachers are passionate about their subjects and teaching style. Subject matter is demonstrated with confidence that is reflected in their energy, enthusiasm and in the diversity of their teaching methods.

Testing and Feedback

Testing helps the students to analyze their comprehensive level. They realize their potential and they become aware of their weaknesses. Testing followed by feedback helps the students to grow in knowledge, skills and understanding. Extra time is given to weak students so that they could draw their levels up.

Tests/ Examinations

Internal Assessments

Students are examined in various ways in addition to the end of term examination by assessments of class work and tests. Tests are designed on monthly basis to detect any deficiency.

Reporting

At the end of each term, a progress report is sent to parents regarding the performance of their children. Meetings with the teachers can be arranged at any time to discuss the problems/performance of a student by coordinator. However parents are strongly advised to attend Parent/Teacher meetings that are scheduled frequently.

Promotion

At the end of the school year, student will be promoted to the next class if their overall performance throughout the year is found satisfactory.

Co-Curricular Activities

Developing leadership skills is a very important part of the education at UCS. By the time pupils leave the school they will have invariably taken on considerable roles of responsibility.

We aim to produce talented, confident, articulate and adaptable leaders who will be equipped to grasp the opportunities presented to them at large. The school has excellent in door and out door sports facilities. Quiz, drama, declamation contests, skits and other healthy co-curricular activities are also regular features of the School.

Rules & Regulations

In order to facilitate your child, we follow certain rules which help us to work together efficiently and smoothly.

Discipline

We believe that all students have ability to mould themselves and can be well aware of their responsibility, if they are given appropriate instructions and tidy environment. To get a standard education, discipline code administered by school management should be followed.

At UCS we believe that children are happier and more secure in a calm and well disciplined environment. We ensure the student's awareness of the consequences of their actions through discussion and so gain their confidence and promote self-discipline.

Along with parents, we work to teach children appropriate discipline. The school has a 'Discipline Policy' and any cases of repeatedly poor behavior will be dealt within line with the policy. Persistent bad behavior is always discussed with parents in order to agree an effective policy to resolve the problem.

Language

English is a language of all instructions and conversations. Our students are expected to speak English while on campus, even during lunch and play time. This helps to build vocabulary and fosters retention of language skills.

Attendance

Regular attendance is compulsory for all students at school. Frequent absence from school affects the learning process which becomes difficult to cover later and cannot be maintained even by taking notes from fellows. Therefore the students are required to be regular and punctual.

Assembly

We have an assembly every morning for all the children. Our assemblies are very much related to developing a sense of community, respect for others, caring attitudes and moral values. The assemblies take various forms such as story telling, sharing, discussion and singing, and different occasions are led by the staff and the students.

Dress Code

Uniform is compulsory for students and can be obtained from shops specified by the school.

Bullying

At UCS we firmly believe that "Bullying in any form is unacceptable". The staff of the school seeks at all times through discussion and learning opportunities to encourage students to have respect and consideration for others in their daily lives.

Jewelry

Jewelry should not be worn at school by the students in the interest of their Health and Safety

Toys

Toys should not be brought to school-unless specifically requested by the teachers.

Identity Cards

To ensure your child's security, ID cards to all newly admitted students are issued. In case a card is misplaced duplicate card is issued on payment of Rs 200/-
